- To be listened to

- Chance to learn more about the world, world events and where they live
 - *To learn about where we live, other countries and languages*
- Opportunities to be involved in choosing what they learn; what interests and inspires them
 - *To have a say in what we learn*
- Occasions to work in teams, to learn from one another
 - *To work with our friends and have chances to share our ideas others*
- Opportunities to learn alongside family members
 - *To learn with our families*
- Chance to communicate learning through the use of technologies and other resources
 - *To have computers, staff and resources to help us*
